### **Dear WME Partners and Supporters,**

FOR MORE THAN 60 YEARS, WE HAVE ADDRESSED THE NEEDS OF HOPELESS CHILDREN. OF THE TENS OF THOUSANDS WHO HAVE COME UNDER OUR CARE, SOME WERE COMPLETELY ORPHANED AND HAD NO FAMILY. OTHERS WERE ABANDONED, LEFT ON THE STREETS, TO SURVIVE ON THEIR OWN. SOME HAD PARENTS PUSHING THEM INTO HARD LABOR, SERVITUDE, THE SEX TRADE, OR TEEN MARRIAGES. AND SOME PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS WERE FORCED TO GIVE UP THEIR CHILDREN DUE TO DISEASE, DISABILITY, EXTREME POVERTY, OR OLD AGE. FOR MORE THAN SIX DECADES OUR HOMES IN INDIA HAVE MET THE CHALLENGES FACED BY THESE CHILDREN, AND THANKS TO PEOPLE LIKE YOU, HAVE BUILT A BRIDGE FROM HOPELESSNESS TO HOPE AND FROM INSECURITY TO SECURITY. GENERATIONS HAVE BENEFITED FROM WME SPONSORSHIP.

You and I know you can't provide a homeless child with either hope or security without first providing them with a secure place to live. That is why WME, since our earliest days, has been involved in the construction, operation, and maintenance of Children's Homes.

SADLY, MANY NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS HAVE STOPPED OPERATING CHILDREN'S HOMES BECAUSE IT IS INCREDIBLY HARD WORK, REQUIRING SIGNIFICANT FINANCIAL RESOURCES, AND A LONG-TERM COMMITMENT. THAT'S WHY THE WORK OF WME CHILDREN'S HOMES IS MORE IMPORTANT TODAY THAN IT WAS SIXTY-FOUR YEARS AGO. WE ARE FILLING A GAP FEW OTHERS ARE FILLING, MEETING NEEDS OTHERS IGNORE, AND SAVING LIVES THAT WOULD BE LOST. IT IS A MISSION THAT WORKED THEN AND IS STILL WORKING NOW!



**Several of our homes urgently need upgrades to their water systems. Disruptions in water supplies have created issues at these homes.**



**Pots, pans, stoves, ovens, beds, bedding, and towels need to be replaced in several homes.**

Our homes are all different. We have some with as few as a dozen children and others with more than 100. The ages of our children range from toddlers to teenagers. While some of our WME Children's Homes are new, others have been used for over 40 years. And each has specific needs we must meet. **To build, operate, and maintain Children's Homes, WME has relied on the financial support and the prayers of partners just like you.** Helping underwrite maintenance and operating costs is a wonderful way to focus your faith and giving. We have general needs where we need help listed on the next page, and what follows are three specific places where we need help right now!

**1. IN OUR WME CHILDREN'S HOME AT BHUBANESWAR WE NEED TO REPLACE OUR GAS STOVES AND COOKING VESSELS. IN ADDITION WE NEED PLATES, BOWLS, CUPS, GLASSES, AND OTHER KITCHEN UTENSILS TO PREPARE AND SERVE MEALS**

***World Missionary Evangelism, Inc. is a wholly separate and independent organization. Its headquarters are in Dallas, Texas.***

TO OUR CHILDREN. There is also a need for a water purifier, water storage drums, food grain storage containers, etc. **This is an urgent need. The cost for purchasing the kitchen utensils is \$2,000. The water purifier is \$1,000.**

2. AT OUR WME 40-YEAR-OLD CHILDREN'S HOME IN BHUBANESWAR OUR BORE WELL, WATER TANK, AND TAPS ARE DAMAGED AND AFFECTING OUR DRINKING WATER, KITCHEN USE, AND CHILDREN'S BATHING. THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM IS ALSO DAMAGED. To fix all these issues we need to construct a water tank as well as fix pipelines and water taps. **The cost for reworking our water system is \$6,000. The cost for fixing our drainage issue is \$1,000.**

3. OUR CHEBROLE CHILDREN'S HOME HAS WATER ISSUES. We need a new storage tank and well for the home. **The cost of drilling the well, the piping, pump, and electrical work is \$9,000.**
