



## USA FOOD FOR HUNGER REACHING HOMELESS VETERANS

**Dear WME Partners and Supporters,**

World Missionary Evangelism's Food for Hunger USA program is a 365 days a year mission that reaches the poorest people in three areas...Huntington, West Virginia, Dallas, Texas, and Mission, Texas. As most of you surely know, right now WME is purchasing and wrapping Christmas gifts for children who come from families unable to buy presents, as well as putting together food baskets for these families to help sustain them through the holidays. In a very real sense, this Christmas program is a billboard for our USA work, but it only touches the surface of all we do.

**IN 2023, THERE IS AN AREA OF FOCUS THAT'S BECOME A MUCH MORE VITAL PART OF WME'S FOOD FOR HUNGER USA OUTREACH...THE ISSUE OF HOMELESSNESS.**

While we have long reached those on the streets in Dallas, we have recently discovered that more and more of those who have no homes are U.S. Armed Forces veterans. **THERE ARE MORE THAN 30,000 HOMELESS VETERANS IN THE UNITED STATES, AND A MAJORITY OF THEM CAN BE FOUND IN THE SOUTH AND SOUTHWEST. IN THE DALLAS-FORT WORTH METROPOLITAN AREA THERE ARE THOUSANDS OF VETERANS WHO LIVE ON THE STREETS.** What are we doing for these forgotten souls?



**This is where many sleep, they only have what they can carry, they have no one to turn to, and they live in the USA.**

**FIRST, WE ARE WORKING THROUGH LOCAL FEEDING PROGRAMS TO PROVIDE MEALS. WE ARE ALSO INVOLVED WITH SHELTERS THAT PROVIDE SAFE PLACES FOR THESE MEN AND WOMEN TO STAY. WE DISTRIBUTE ITEMS SUCH AS TOILETRIES, CLOTHES, COATS, BLANKETS, SLEEPING BAGS, AND UMBRELLAS. AND, WHILE WE ARE WITH THEM, THEY ARE CONSTANTLY REMINDED HOW VALUABLE THEIR SERVICE WAS AND HOW MUCH WE LOVE AND APPRECIATE EACH OF THEM.**



**On the street, alone, forgotten, are thousands of veterans who served the US in combat.**

Why are these veterans on the street? There is no one answer, but there are two things most of them have in common; they came back from tours of duty with PTSD and there was a breakdown in their family unit. At one time, most had a job and lost it, then they lost their home and car, and found themselves with no place to go but the streets. Now they fight a daily battle to survive. In fact, some have seen more violence and experienced more heartache while homeless than they did on battlefields. We need to help rebuild these men and women's confidence, security, and lives. But there is even more to WME USA programs than just the facets we have already cited.

**FOOD FOR HUNGER USA HAS PANTRIES THAT PROVIDE FOOD FOR THE POOR ALL YEAR LONG.**

We serve all ages, races, and backgrounds. Some of those who depend upon this mission are homeless vets, but most are senior citizens and poor families with young children. The love and respect they receive while visiting our pantries is possibly as important as the food, clothing, and other household items we distribute.
